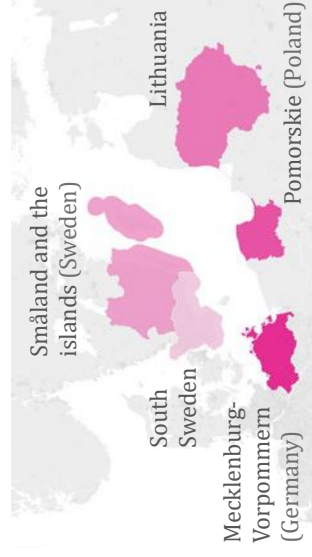


Development of UNESCO Natural and Cultural assets
